WHY LINKUS?

LinkUS is Central Ohio's comprehensive transportation initiative to help address growth, affordability and opportunity gaps in our community.



GROWTH

Since 2010, the regional population has grown by +250,000 people, with 70% of that growth in Franklin County. By 2050, the regional population is projected to exceed 725,000.

AFFORDABILITY

Since 2020, the median home sale price has increased by 68%, and the average household spends more than \$12,000 per year on transportation.

OPPORTUNITY GAPS

40,000 Franklin County
households lack access to a
personal vehicle, and 1/3 of
Franklin County residents live in
areas of low or very
low opportunity.



What is Rapid Transit?

The three LinkUS corridors in design will utilize bus rapid transit or BRT and have dedicated lanes for transit with premium stations in the center lane where possible. BRT will operate on 15 minute or less intervals and function similar to light rail but can be built quicker and at 1/6 of the cost.
