<u>Home Buyer Education</u> (HBE)

HBE participants will learn how to obtain, maintain and retain a home of their own!

Home Buyer Education is a total of eight hours instruction (two four-hour sessions: **HBE 1 and HBE 2**) and budget/credit counseling.

Those who complete eight hours of group instruction and participate in one-on-one budget/credit counseling will receive a HUD-approved Certificate of Completion, which is often required by lenders for down payment/closing cost assistance programs and/or grants.

Upon completion of the full 8-hour course, you will receive a Certificate of Completion and qualify for a *free* one-hour, one-on-one Budget/Credit Counseling session.

Super Savers Club (SSC)

OSU Extension can help you establish an *Emergency Savings Fund*.

Only income eligible participants, who successfully complete the OSU Extension **MM or HBE** workshops will receive an invitation to join the SSC.

SSC members who save up to \$600 in a *SAVING ACCOUNT* are eligible to receive a maximum of \$600 after 90 days of saving and completing additional online MM modules.
